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Training platform

Context

To stimulate the economic growth and fight unemployment, the European Commission considers the free mobility of workers and citizens as one of the most important rights to be encouraged, because it is an essential component of the common labour market.

Objectives

The project's objective is to promote the free and successful movement of workers in Europe through the use of a Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL) methodology. For this purpose, the partnership has developed a training platform to support all the people who wish to acquire work experience in another European country, providing them with both vocational guidance and language training.

Training platform

The platform is available in the national language of the partners (English, French, German, Italian and Spanish) and is structured following the CLIL methodology. The training platform is available for B2 and C1 levels and is divided in four modules addressing the following topics:

1. Job search skills
2. Job applications
3. Interview skills
4. Intercultural skills

Using various supports (texts, videos, audio files...), the platform enhance the learner's communication in a foreign language while providing them with vocational guidance on such topics as:

- How to write an effective CV,
- How to write an effective cover letter,
- How to behave during a job interview,
- What are the best channels to find a job,
- Etc.

Target groups

The target users of the training platform are adults, both employed and unemployed, who have completed or are completing their education and are planning to look for a job abroad to start their professional life, to make new experiences or to find a better position.

Impact

- The project will contribute to change the mindset of European workers and to make them plan their professional life not only in national but in European terms.
- The project is also going to encourage trainers and guidance operators to include CLIL methodology-based tools into their activities. Thereby the project will contribute to exploit this effective methodology outside the usual path of formal education demonstrating that it could be particularly useful in the field of adult education.
- Ultimately the greatest impact will be to foster in Europe a well-performing training system that provides European workers with the skills required by the labour market and the economy.
- The partners and the organisations involved in the project's implementation will embed the platform into their usual training and guidance activities, ensuring the sustainability of the results.
